Tropical enumerative geometry

In tropical geometry, algebraic varieties are degenerated to polyhedral complexes from which important features can be deduced. Tropical geometry has important applications in enumerative geometry, in which we count geometric objects satisfying conditions. Such counts can often be expressed in terms of intersection theory on suitable moduli spaces. We present recent developments involving tropical curve counts.
